UPPER-DIVISION MAJOR

36 UD units are required, distributed as follows:

- A. One course from: Anthropology 100, 112Z, 143F, 181, 182; Art History 103H 4 _____
- B. Three courses from: Classics 114, 155, 165, 170; Art History 103A-B-C-E-F-G, 186B 12 _____
- C. Two courses from: Classics 101, 102, 106, 109, 110, 130, 140, 175, 178, 180A-B, 190
or any upper-division Greek or Latin 8 _____
- D. Two courses from: Classics 145, 150, 151, 152, 171; History 111A-B-C-F-T, 112A-C-D 8 _____
- E. Classics 185 (or Classics 195A-B for Honors) 4 _____

- Notes:** - Other UD courses not listed above that have a strong classical archaeology component may be substituted by petition.
- In the first quarter of their junior year, all majors must make an appointment with the undergraduate advisor to review their progress towards meeting the requirements of the major.

MAJOR REGULATIONS

- PREREQUISITES** Check the *General Catalog* for the prerequisites to all listed courses.
- P/NP GRADING OPTION** Up to 8 units total of Greek 199 and Latin 199 may be taken P/NP for major credit; all other courses must be taken for letter grades, including those applied to the major from other departments.
- SUBSTITUTIONS** In the major requirements permissible only by petition to the department chair and dean.
- G.P.A REQUIREMENTS** At least 2.0 overall UC average in **all** upper-division major courses **and** **all** courses (Prep and UD) for the major.
- DOUBLE MAJORS** With the approval of each department chairperson, up to a total of 8 units may be applied simultaneously to both UD majors.
