- In the first quarter of their junior year, all majors must make an appointment with the undergraduate advisor to review their progress towards meeting the requirements of the major.**MAJOR REGULATIONS****PREREQUISITES** Check the *General Catalog* for the prerequisites to all listed courses.**P/NP GRADING OPTION** Up to 8 units total of Greek 199 and Latin 199 may be taken P/NP for major credit; all other courses must be taken for letter grades, including those applied to the major from other departments.**SUBSTITUTIONS** In the major requirements permissible only by petition to the department chair and dean.**G.P.A REQUIREMENTS** At least 2.0 overall UC average in **all** upper-division major courses and **all** courses (Prep and UD) for the major.**DOUBLE MAJORS** With the approval of each department chairperson, up to a total of 8 units may be applied simultaneously to both UD majors.
