B. 12 units of Greek and or Latin, including either Greek 100 and 101 or Latin 100 and 101 12 _____

C. 8 units selected from the following Classics courses in ancient Greek and Roman cultures:

101, 102, 106, 109, 130, 140, 145, 150, 151, 155, 175, 178, 180A, 180B, 190 8 _____

Note: Up to 4 units of the 12 may be from an upper division course in any ancient culture, by petition through Classics Department.

D. Classics 185 (or Classics 195A-B for Honors) 4 _____

Notes: - Other UD courses not listed above that have a strong ancient philosophy component may be substituted by petition.

- In the first quarter of their junior year, all majors must make an appointment with the undergraduate advisor to review their progress towards meeting the requirements of the major.

MAJOR REGULATIONS**PREREQUISITES** Check the *General Catalog* for the prerequisites to all listed courses.**P/NP GRADING OPTION** Up to 8 units total of Greek 199 and Latin 199 may be taken P/NP for major credit; all other courses must be taken for letter grades, including those applied to the major from other departments.**SUBSTITUTIONS** In the major requirements permissible only by petition to the department chair and dean.**G.P.A REQUIREMENTS** At least 2.0 overall UC average in **all** upper-division major courses **and** **all** courses (Prep and UD) for the major.**DOUBLE MAJORS** With the approval of each department chairperson, up to a total of 8 units may be applied simultaneously to both UD majors.
